The Grand Jury of the county of San Joaquin, State of California, accuses the defendant of committing in the county of San Joaquin and within other counties, pursuant to Penal Code section 790(B) in the State of California, before the finding of this indictment, the following crime(s):

COUNT ONE: On or about 9/11/77, the defendant, ROGER REECE KIBBE, did commit a FELONY, namely a violation of 187 of the Penal Code, MURDER, in that said defendant did willfully and unlawfully and intentionally and with malice aforethought murder LOU ELLEN BURLEIGH, a human being.

COUNT TWO: For a further and separate cause of action being a different offense of the same class of crime from the charge as set forth in COUNT ONE and connected in its commission with all other offenses in the indictment, complainant further complains and says: On or about 4/21/86, the defendant, ROGER REECE KIBBE, did commit a FELONY, namely a violation of 187 of the Penal Code, MURDER, in that said defendant did willfully and unlawfully and intentionally and with malice aforethought murder LORA HEEDICK, a human being.

COUNT THREE: For a further and separate cause of action being a different offense of the same class of crime from the charge as set forth in COUNT TWO and connected in its commission with all other offenses in the indictment, complainant further complains and says: On or about 7/3/86, the defendant, ROGER REECE KIBBE, did commit a FELONY, namely a violation of 187 of the Penal Code, MURDER, in that said defendant did willfully and unlawfully and intentionally and with malice aforethought murder BARBARA ANN SCOTT, a human being.

COUNT FOUR: For a further and separate cause of action being a different offense of the same class of crime from the charge as set forth in COUNT THREE and connected in its commission with all other offenses in the indictment, complainant further complains and says: On or about 7/15/86, the defendant, ROGER REECE KIBBE, did commit a FELONY, namely a violation of 187 of the Penal Code, MURDER, in

that said defendant did willfully and unlawfully and intentionally and with malice aforethought murder STEPHANIE BROWN, a human being.

COUNT FIVE: For a further and separate cause of action being a different offense of the same class of crime from the charge as set forth in COUNT FOUR and connected in its commission with all other offenses in the indictment, complainant further complains and says: On or about 8/17/86, the defendant, ROGER REECE KIBBE, did commit a FELONY, namely a violation of 187 of the Penal Code, MURDER, in that said defendant did willfully and unlawfully and intentionally and with malice aforethought murder CHARMAINE SABRAH, a human being.

COUNT SIX: For a further and separate cause of action being a different offense of the same class of crime from the charge as set forth in COUNT FIVE and connected in its commission with all other offenses in the indictment, complainant further complains and says: On or about 11/5/86, the defendant, ROGER REECE KIBBE, did commit a FELONY, namely a violation of 187 of the Penal Code, MURDER, in that said defendant did willfully and unlawfully and intentionally and with malice aforethought murder KATHERINE KELLY QUINONES, a human being.

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE (MURDER WITH PREVIOUS MURDER CONVICTION) AS TO COUNT ONE, TWO, THREE, FOUR, FIVE, and SIX, IT IS FURTHER ALLEGED said defendant, ROGER REECE KIBBE, has committed Intentional first degree murder as to each count alleged, and said defendant was previously convicted of first degree murder on March 18, 1991, in the Superior Court of the State of California and for the County of El Dorado within the meaning of Penal Code section 190.2(A)(2) and 190.2(C)(5)(1977).

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE (MURDER IN THE COMMISSION OF A FELONY, KIDNAPPING) AS TO COUNT ONE, TWO, THREE, FOUR, FIVE AND SIX, IT IS FURTHER ALLEGED said defendant, ROGER REECE KIBBE, has committed Intentional First Degree Murders and committed each murder count alleged while engaged in a Kidnapping within the meaning of Penal Code section 190.2(A)17 and 190.2(C)(3)(1977).

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE (MURDER IN THE COMMISSION OF A FELONY, RAPE) AS TO COUNT ONE, TWO, THREE, FOUR, FIVE AND SIX IT IS FURTHER ALLEGED said defendant, ROGER REECE KIBBE, has committed Intentional First Degree Murders and committed each murder count alleged while engaged in a Rape within the meaning of Penal Code section 190.2(A)17 and 190.2(C)(3)(1977).

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE (MURDER IN THE COMMISSION OF A FELONY, FORCED ORAL COPULATION) AS TO COUNT THREE IT IS FURTHER ALLEGED that said defendant, ROGER REECE KIBBE, has committed Intentional First Degree Murder while engaged in Forcible Oral Copulation within the meaning of Penal Code section 190.2(A)17.

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE (MULTIPLE MURDERS) AS TO COUNT ONE, TWO,

THREE, FOUR, FIVE AND SIX, IT IS FURTHER ALLEGED said defendant, ROGER REECE KIBBE, has committed, of the presently charged offenses, at least one offense of Intentional First Degree Murder and more than one offense of Intentional Murder of the First or Second Degree within the meaning of Penal Code section 190.2(A)(3) and 190.2(C)(5)(1977).
