


ORDER FOR RECIPROCAL DISCOVERY


NOW, on this the 11th day of May, 2005, the State of Kansas by its attorney, KIM T. PARKER, Chief Deputy District Attorney, and the defendant by his attorney, Charles S. Osburn, Chief Public Defender hereby agree that the State's request and motion for reciprocal discovery filed May 6, 2005, shall be sustained in full as to paragraphs 3 and 4, and in accordance with K.S.A. 22-3212 subsection (c). The State's request in paragraph 2 shall be sustained in part and the defendant shall be allowed to copy CD's and DVD's provided by the State, but all copies and original copies provided by the State to the defense shall remain in the possession and control of counsel for the defendant at all times.
